Reservations at Texas State Parks are open now with a five month window. Weekend dates at the State Parks fill up quickly so you have to plan ahead. Temporary guidelines for State Park use:

- *Face coverings are required inside all state park buildings.
- *Maintain at least a six-foot distance from anyone not in your group.
- *No groups larger than 10 people are allowed, except for families or people living in the same household.
