Driving Directions :

From Dallas: Take 635 south towards 175
Take 175 south towards Kaufman. Continue past Kaufman to Mabank.

At Mabank exit onto 198. You will turn right onto 198.
DO NOT SPEED!

Continue through Mabank & Gun Barrel City. DO NOT SPEED!

Continue on 198 to 3-way intersection. This is at a dead end with a stop sign.

Turn right to continue on 198 towards Payne Springs.
198 does some winding around.

Drive past fire station. Turn right onto Clear Creek Road, (CR 2531). (Payne Springs Self Storage on corner). Pinnacle direction sign is posted at intersection. Continue on Clear Creek Road (CR 2531) through 4-way stop sign. Continue forward until you get to the stone Pinnacle Club gate entrance. Here you follow the curve in the road to the left. You do not enter Pinnacle.

Take the first left.

Take the first left again.

Take the first right.

Our trailer is 2182 Hickory Street in Esquire Estates I.
It is on the left and light beige in color.

If you use Garmin or car GPS system, put in the intersection of Hickory Street and Elm Street in Mabank. Turn right at that intersection.




Remembering Jeanette Flowers

I'm glad to have known her, done so many fun things with her, and have helped her a bit when she was injured.




