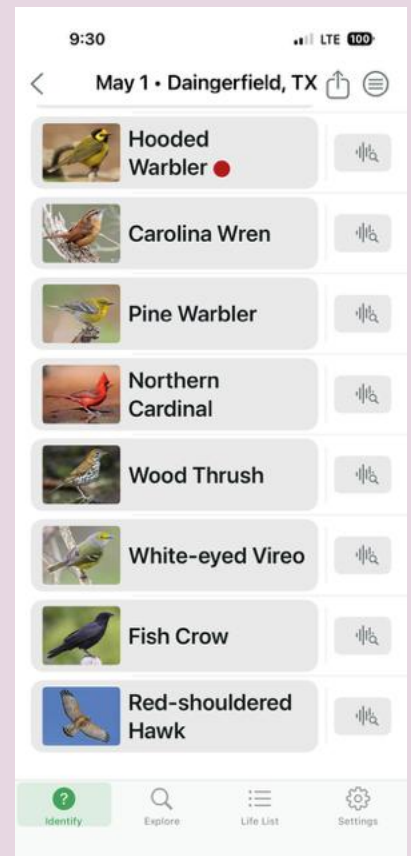
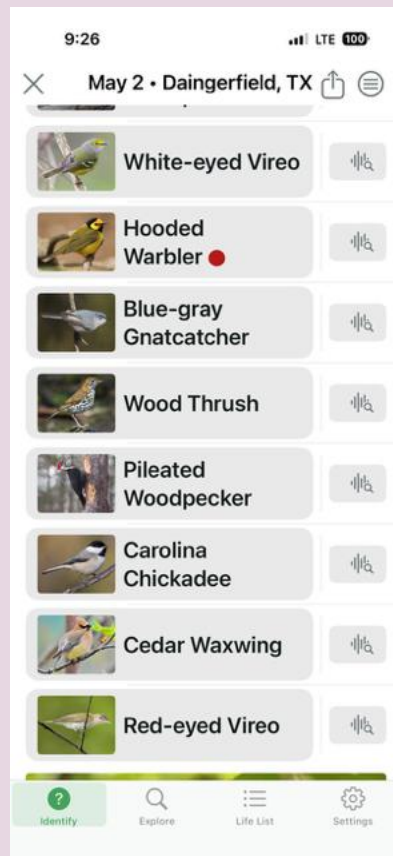
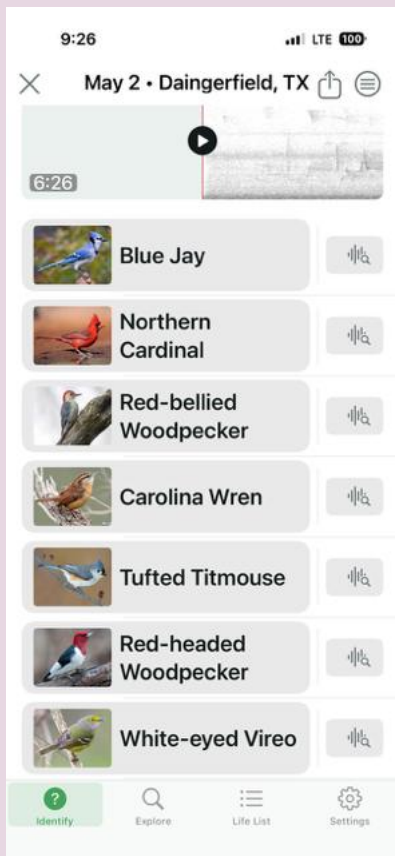
Daingerfield State Park

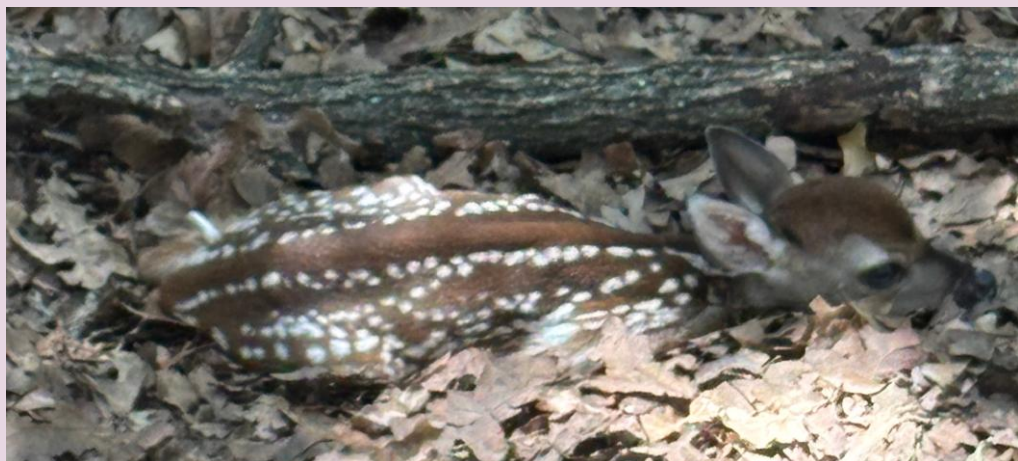

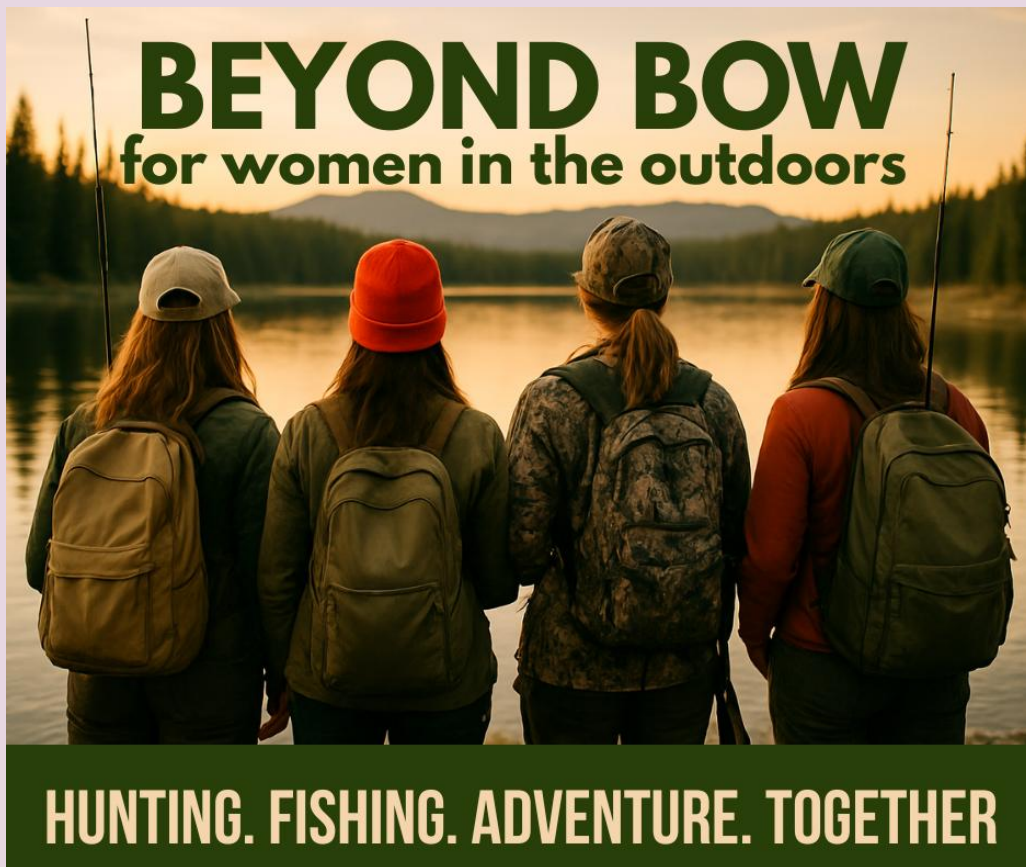

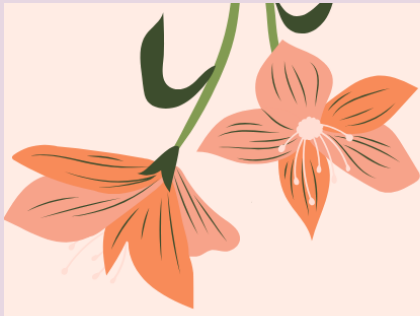
Becoming an Outdoors-Woman

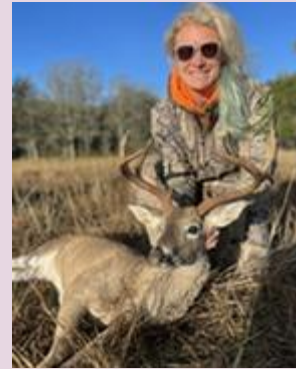
